(Scholarship award proceeds are directed to and managed by your institution's bursar office. Award funds will be applied to the student's continuing education expense account.)

Nominee Qualifications:

- <u>High School Seniors</u> currently in wood study programs <u>and who plan to attend a post-secondary</u> woodwork education program and/or,
- **Post-secondary woodworking students,** currently enrolled in a woodwork education program.

AWIEF Scholarship Application Form – Information Requirements:

3. Recognition Awards

Academic, extracurricular or community recognition awards you have received in high school or college. All applicants must submit high school and/or collegiate transcripts including class rank (if calculated) and grades from the most recent grading period. CGPA is preferred and must be weighted or unweighted on a 4.0 scale.

6. Education and Training Experience
