Scholarship Submittal Deadline is Friday, April 25, 2014

The AWIEF Annual Scholarship program invites woodwork instructors to nominate one (1) outstanding student per year as a scholarship applicant nominee. Nominations are open to High School Seniors currently in wood study programs who also plan to attend a post-secondary woodwork education program and also, students currently enrolled in a post-secondary woodworking programs.

- 2. Grade Point Averages High School and/or Current enrollment GPA

3. Recognition Awards

Academic, extracurricular or community recognition awards you have received in high school or college. If there is additional information about your education, experience or achievements you wish to share with the judges, you may add another sheet if necessary.

4. Scholastic Transcripts

All applicants must submit high school and/or collegiate transcripts including class rank (if calculated) and grades from the most recent grading period. CGPA is preferred and must be weighted or unweighted on a 4.0 scale.

9. Work Experience
