	1.	Review the Portable Power Sander Safety Rules.			
	2.	Obtain a $34'' \times 12'' \times 12'' +/-$ veneered overlay material which has been sanded cross-grain.			
_	3.	Obtain abrasives from your instructor. Using a $1/2$ sheet pad sander, sand one side using *120 and 180 grit paper. (*Start with a rougher grit if needed. <u>Label this side "A"</u>			
-	4.	Using a pneumatic random orbit sander, sand the other side of the board using 120 and 180 grit disks. <u>Label this side "B".</u>			
	5.	Using an inspection light, verify that all rough grits have been removed. Apply a dye stain to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the surface on each face before submitting for review.
