## **Information Sheet 1**

## **RADIAL ARM SAW SAFETY RULES**

- 1. Follow all General Machine Safety Rules.
- 2. Keep your hands out of the line of cut.
- 3. Hold the stock firmly against the fence.
- 4. Do not move the stock unless the saw blade is behind the fence.
- 5. Do not feed the blade into the work too fast. Hardness and thickness of the stock determine the rate of feed.
- 6. In the Madison College Cabinetmaking Lab, the radial arm saw will NOT be used for ripping.
- 7. Make sure all stock is free of nails or other foreign material.
- 8. Use extension tables to support the ends of long boards.
- 9. Refer to Miter Saw Safety Rules (Unit 2.3) for correct placement when cutting bowed material.
